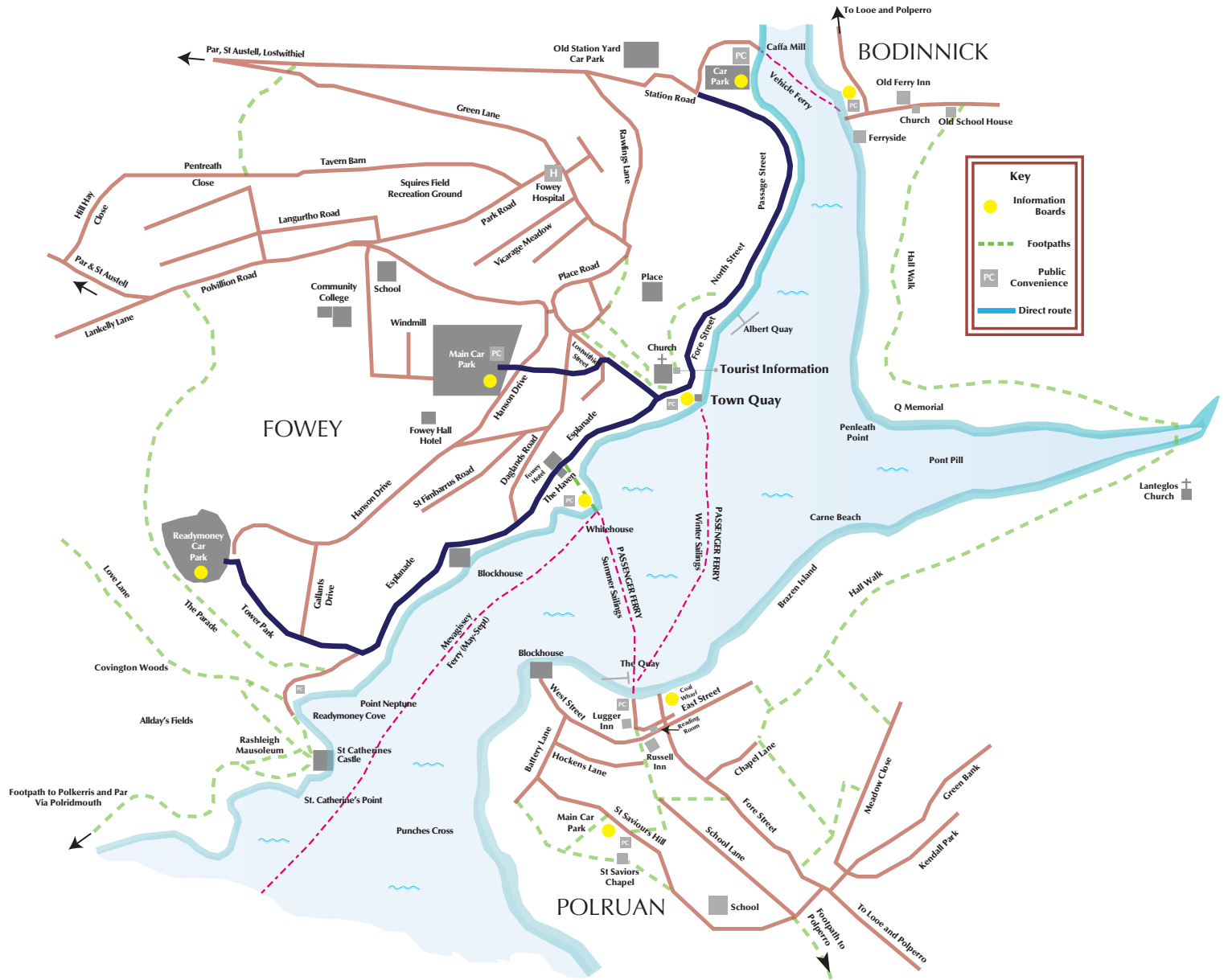


Direct Route Fowey



Fowey Direct Routes from Car Parks

Fowey has much to offer and these routes take you into the centre of the historic town with its old buildings from the main car parks with many viewpoints along the way. An historic seaport, Fowey is the main exporting port for China Clay, it also plays host to 7000 visiting yachts a year. At the heart of the town is the Town Quay. From here you can take a boat trip around the harbour (seasonal) or just sit and watch all the activities on the river.

From **Readymoney Beach Car Park**, turn out of the car park and turn right or take the footpath signed to the beach, follow the path and then turn left at the end. It takes about fifteen minutes to walk to the centre and it is mostly level or downhill. As you walk along the Esplanade you will have excellent views of the river and Polruan on the other side.

From **Main Car Park** it is about an eight minute downhill walk. There are several sets of steps, this route is unsuitable for pushchairs. On this route you have good views of the Church and Place the home of the Treffry family.

From **Caffa Mill Car Park** it takes about ten minutes to walk to the centre. This is all road walking and the streets are very narrow, all the traffic will be coming towards you. There is a slight incline but then the last part is downhill. You will get views of the river and Bodinnick on the other shore at the start of the walk.

There are many historic points of interest on the way and to assist you there are interpretation panels at Caffa Mill car park, Main car park, Readymoney Car Park, Whitehouse slip and Fowey Town Quay.
