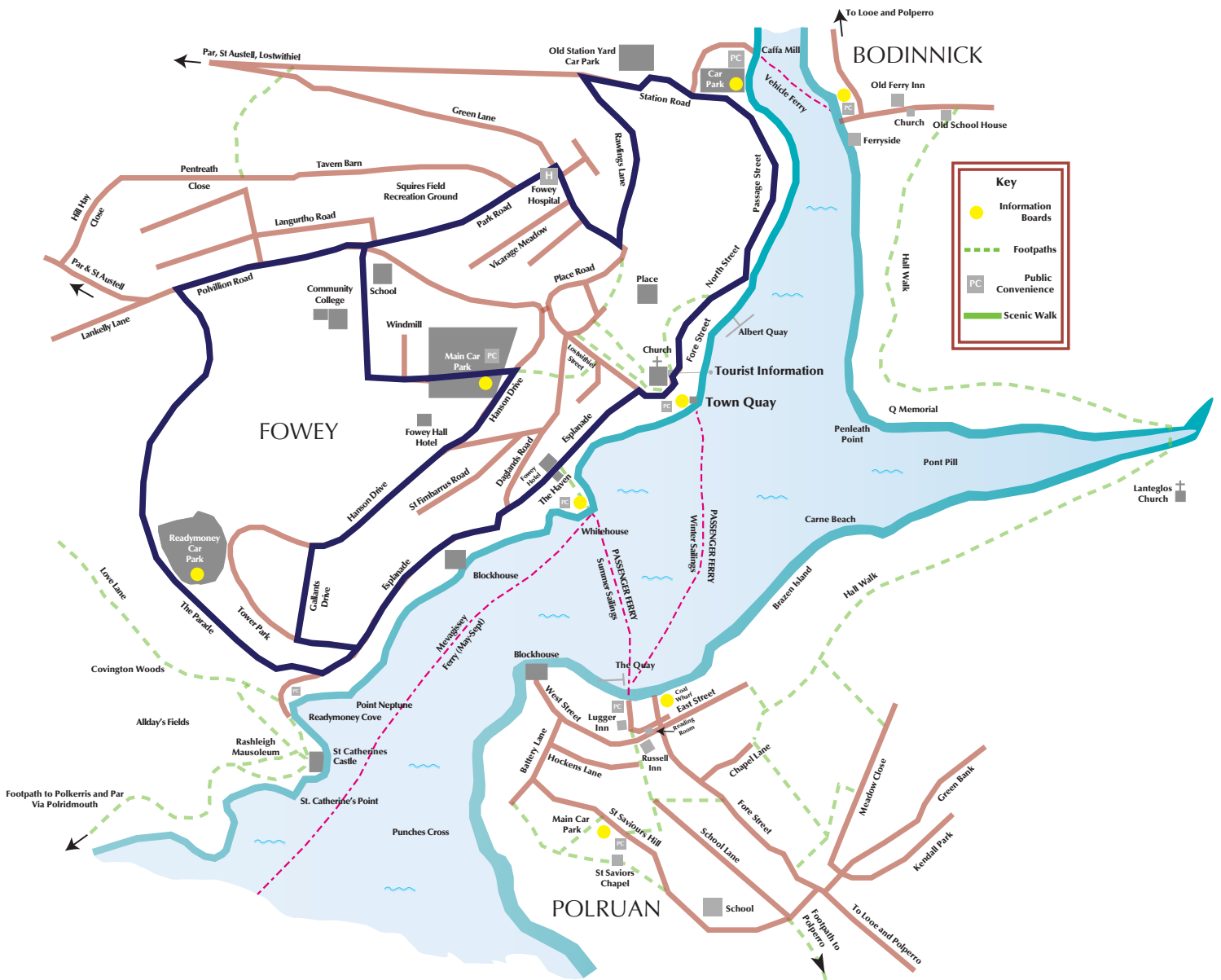


# Scenic Walk Fowey



## Fowey Scenic Route

Duration: About two hours to make the long circuit. The shorter circuit takes about one hour.

Terrain: Mostly road or pavement with one unmade track. As Fowey is on the side of a hill going down to the river you will encounter a hill on the walk from any of the starting points. Many of the streets are very narrow (one car wide) so do take care.

Fowey has much to offer and this route will take you past old and new parts of the town. There are many viewpoints on the way, so do have your camera ready. An historic seaport, Fowey is the main exporting port for China Clay, it also plays host to 7000 visiting yachts a year. There is always something interesting to see on the river and there are many view points on the walk. The centre of the town is the Town Quay; this is the heart of the town. From here you can take a boat trip around the harbour (seasonal) or just sit and watch all the activities on the river.

There is much interesting history in this area and to assist you there are interpretation panels at Caffa Mill car park, Main car park, Readymoney Car Park, Whitehouse slip and Fowey Town Quay.
